

Suggested list of activities

Nation-wide celebration of National Doctor's day (1 July 2022) may be done in the following ways:-

Hashtag : #ThankYouDoctors

1. "Ek Shaam Doctor Ke Naam"

- A cultural event of recitations, songs and performances singing the glory of doctors of the country may be conducted in Medical Colleges, State Government Hospitals, Central Government Hospitals, District Hospital, Community Health Centres and Health and Wellness Centres.
- Administration may organize this event at prominent places of every district and block headquarters.

2. Plaque/Certificate for the doctors of 75 or more age group

- An award to be given to all practicing doctors who are 75 years of age or above.
- To be carried out at every block of the country by the Block Administration.
- Award could be a certificate, a rose, a plaque or anything which is suitable and appropriate.
- Photos of the awards ceremony could be shared by all concerned in social media and popularised hashtag #ThankYouDoctors.

3. Nation-wide Social Media Campaign – "Ek Selfie Doctor Ke Saath"

- A social media campaign where a selfie being taken by anybody along with their personal doctor or any doctor of their choice.
- Encourage individuals to post in their individual social media page and ask them to hashtag the MoHFW's hashtag #ThankYouDoctors.

4. Hospital based Exhibitions

- Bigger Hospitals can also organize exhibitions to highlight the growth of India's Healthcare in all spheres: expertise, technology, specialties, drugs, equipment etc.

5. Visit by the doctors of local hospital to schools, colleges and old age homes

- Doctor and other Health Staff to visit schools to do advocacy on Healthy living
- COVID appropriate behaviours etc.
- Sensitise how a doctor works in the hospitals to take care of the Community
- Specialised services to the under privileged in orphanages, old age home residents.
